Funding

SCVO is a key source of funding information for the third sector. Funds that may be of interest include:

- **UK Government - Community Ownership Fund**
Provides support funding the purchase/renovation costs of community assets and amenities which will provide long term benefits to communities. Expressions of Interest can be submitted at any time, next bidding window closes 14 April 2023.
- **NatureScot - The Facility for Investment Ready Nature in Scotland**
Supports projects that use private investment and market-based mechanisms to finance the restoration of Scotland's Nature. Deadline for Expression of Interest 17 April 2023.
- **Volant Charitable Trust**
Supports organisations addressing poverty and deprivation, with an emphasis on women and young people. Next deadline 25 April 2023.
