

1. Answer: D, 17 times bigger

In fact, the UK has contributed 240 times more to the total share of global emissions than Côte d'Ivoire. With those two statistics cocoa farmers - often earning far less than a living income thanks to our deeply unfair trade system - are left to deal with the effects of the climate crisis they did so little to cause.





So Kenyan roses can have a smaller carbon footprint than Dutch ones as they have not been grown in heated glasshouses / polytunnels.
