Energy Saving Trust - Energy Redress Scheme

Provides grants to charities and community energy groups that support households most at risk from cold homes and high energy bills. Next deadline 6 Jun 2022.

Paths for All - Walking for Health Fund

Health Walk Grants provide funding for projects to improve wellbeing and reduce ill-health in Scotland through walking programmes. Projects can apply for the cost of initiatives that encourage people to walk more. Next deadline 24 Jun 2022.

• The Gordon & Ena Baxter Foundation

Supports projects with clear benefit to communities in Moray and the Highlands and Islands. They will fund a huge variety of capital projects. Next deadline 27 May 2022.

## Other funds include:

Highland Green Health Small Grant Fund 2022

A small grant fund to help connect people with nature for their improved physical and mental wellbeing. Applications are invited from community groups in the Highland Council area for projects up to the value of £1500. The fund closes 13 June 2022.

• Co-op Local Community Fund

Co-op support projects that make communities fairer for everyone. Application by midnight on 29 May 2022 You can apply if your project:

- o helps improve people's mental wellbeing
- o creates opportunities for young people to be heard and make a difference
