

During 2023, GALE's exceptional work has garnered significant recognition, underscoring the collective efforts of our community. The prestigious awards and acknowledgments received by GALE are a testament to the unwavering commitment of our local staff, volunteers, and members who selflessly contribute their skills and Together, we have created a community-led social enterprise embodies the values of collaboration and inclusivity, making a lasting impact on our community's wellbeing and prosperity.

GALE's achievements have been celebrated through several prestigious accolades, the including Celebrating Communities category at the Highlands and Islands Thistle Awards and the Scotland Loves Local Enterprising Communities Award. Perhaps it can be summed up best by recalling the words of the judging panel at SURF who said, "The judges saw this as an outstanding example of a project which has been developed and delivered by the community for the community. It has empowered local people to own and control local assets important to the area's economy and take an active role in local decision making. The judges liked that the purpose-built facility creates and sustains employment for a large number of local people throughout the year in an economy which is impacted by seasonality, providing access to additional support services. It was evident that the project plays a pivotal role in improving social cohesion for the area."

## SUSTAINABLE EMPLOYMENT

SURF's recognition of the importance of sustainable employment was echoed in our recent Community Action Plan, in which the need to employ and develop opportunities for local jobs for local people emerged as a high priority. The creation and enhancement of employment opportunities are key to community growth, and it's an objective we've been passionate about at GALE for many years.

Despite the challenges faced by the hospitality industry in 2023, GALE has much of which to feel proud. With an annual turnover of approximately £400K, GALE has kept £350K circulating in the local economy through a local-first approach. By employing locals, sourcing services from local businesses and producers, and partnering with charities and community groups, GALE ensures that the wealth generated by its activities remains within the community.

In 2023, GALE employed 33 locals, engaged over 39 local businesses and producers, utilised the services of 27 community bakers, and partnered with 6 charities or community groups. These actions contribute to the overall wellbeing and prosperity of our community.

By leveraging its economic and social strength, GALE functions as an anchor institution, driving the creation of wealth that remains local. As we continue to grow, we remain committed to our social mission, prioritising our local community's wellbeing and contributing to the wider goal of a wellbeing economy.
