Highland Pension Fund Divestment Strategy

AIM:

- council political pledge to divest by COP26 + adopt Highland Charter
- Actual divestment at pension fund March meeting after COP26

Opportunities:

- COP26 political moment + increased interest and public pressure
- Groups across highlands working on their councillors
- Backing and promo from FoES and COP26 Coalition
- Glasgow council commitment as precedent, Fife council adopted a similar motion recently

Challenges:

- Fudging of councillors re: 'net zero' 'political commitments'
- Resistant councillors political conservatism + concern about responsibility
- Capacity and time in groups
- Geography spread out groups

Communication/ ways of working:

- Central campaign with core shared tactics and events
- Groups to use and run with tools in their own way
- Communicate via google group and regular meetings

Key targets:

- Get as many Councillors on board in Highland and Na h-Eileanan an lar as possible- as political pressure is key in run up to COP26
- Pension fund committee

Secondary targets:

- Pension fund officers
- Major employers in the HPF

Background information:

- Research by Friends of the Earth Scotland into Scottish local government pension fund investments in fossil fuels (Feb 2021)
- Blog to summarise the report's findings

Core tactics 2021

- Central e-action to councillors asking to support pledge all groups to circulate widely on social media (launch end of July / early August?)
 - Possibility for street stalls to sign up to send e-action if capacity (August? - early September?)
 - Create social media pack for sharing
- Councillor pledge all groups to meet with local councillors and encourage them to sign the pledge. (launch at same time as eaction, ideally get 3 or 4 councillor pledges for press release?)
 - Share images of councillors who have pledged on social media

- Scope for groups to promote this and share in their own tone
- Create briefing for people meeting councillors on divestment +
 Highland Charter (launch with e-action and pledge)
- Scotland wide lobbying training organised by FoES/Platform (August?)
- Open letter calling on Highland Council and Western Isles to divest for relevant orgs to sign, including organisations and groups who are not based in the Highlands (led by Protect Our Winters)
- Public event in August as part of <u>Skye Climate Festival</u> with the aim of getting more people to take e-action and arrange meetings with councillors.
 - Share via COP26 coalition, FoES, POW and other groups to get mass audience.
 - Take action in meeting 100 e-actions taken in the meeting.
 - Can invite speakers from communities impacted by Highland Council's investments - Mossmorran, Chile BHP mines.
- Motion for divestment put to council September meeting 9th (inspired by Glasgow councillor motion in favour of divestment in April)
 - Find supportive councillors in advance who may put this through, pool knowledge
- Actions in September in run up to council meeting and pension fund meeting

- Possible flyposters with images of destruction caused by investments with QR code to take link
- In person protest at full council meeting and pension fund meeting
- Media articles and op eds pitched from different groups. Working with FoES media team.
 - Youth angle "pension funds destroying our future"
 - International allies "impact of these companies on our lives"
 - POW targeting outdoor industry Open letter from Athletes
- 5th Nov decentralised day of action for divestment across UK (if there is not political commitment yet then big hypocrisy protest)
- 6th Nov Global Day of Action for COP26

Link to COP

- Register as a COP Hub so highland people interested in the COP get directed towards the campaign
- Organise actions on 5th and 6th Nov

Councillor pledge text: e.g.

"I call on the Highland Council Pension Fund to divest from fossil fuels and adopt the Highland Charter for Responsible Investment."
